

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-22

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-157 WITH SCRAP COM INC. FOR THE SALE OF SCRAP COMPRESSED NATURAL GAS (CNG) TANKS IN "AS IS" CONDITION FOR A TOTAL SALE PRICE OF TWENTY SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT AND 40/100 DOLLARS (\$26,858.40).

WHEREAS, four hundred fifty six (456) used CNG tanks have been determined to be scrap in accordance with the Authority's policy; and

WHEREAS, the bids of four companies for said tanks were received on the 30th day of January, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Scrap Com, Inc., to be the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for the four hundred fifty-six (456) scrap CNG tanks hereto and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Scrap Com Inc., whose address is, 3018 East 55th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44127 for the purchase of four hundred fifty-six (456) scrap CNG tanks for a total purchase price of twenty six thousand eight hundred fifty-eight & 40/100 dollars (\$26,858.40) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Scrap Com Inc. for the sale of four hundred fifty-six (456) scrap CNG tanks.


Section 3. That proceeds of said sale in the amount of twenty six thousand eight hundred fifty-eight & 40/100 dollars (\$26,858.40) be deposited into the General Fund.

- 1.0 PURPOSE: This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract for the sale of four hundred fifty-six (456) scrap Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) tanks.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: These CNG tanks have been declared scrap and are of no further functional use to the Authority. Because of a high content of aluminum it was recommended that these tanks be sold on an "as is" basis.
- 3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: Bid packages for the sale of these tanks were sent to twenty companies and/or individuals. Four bids were received by 12:00 Noon on January 30, 2002. The bids are as follows.

Scrap Com Inc.	\$ 58.90
D. Cohen & Sons	\$ 27.00
DeMilta Iron & Metal	\$ 14.59
Stein Inc.	\$ 10.96

- 4.0 DBE/AFFIRMATIVE SECTION BACKGROUND: A DBE goal is not applicable to this sale of tanks.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: This disposal is consistent with the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's policy on disposal of scrap and obsolete property.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: The monies from this sale will be deposited into the General Fund.
- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: Reject all bids. Rejection of all bids will delay the sale of these scrap CNG tanks.
- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the bid of Scrap Com Inc. be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the General Manager to enter into a contract.
