AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2002-105A WITH TRANSIT SALES INTERNATIONAL FOR THE SALE OF TWENTY NINE USED TRANSIT VEHICLES IN "AS IS" CONDITION FOR A TOTAL SALE PRICE OF FIVE THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$5,000.00).

WHEREAS, twenty-nine (29) transit buses have been determined to be obsolete in accordance with the Authority's vehicle replacement policy; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43(k) provides that a regional transit authority shall make a sale or other disposition of property through full and open competition; and

WHEREAS, the bids of two companies for the purchase of said vehicles were received on the 26th day of August, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bids of Transit Sales International to be the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for the items identified in said Attachment A hereto and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Transit Sales International located at 1863 Service Court, Riverside, CA 92507, for the purchase of twenty-nine (29) vehicles, as listed, on Attachment A hereto for a total purchase price of five thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$5,000.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Transit Sales International for the twenty-nine (29) vehicles identified on Attachment A hereto on such terms as are in the best interest of the Authority.

Section 3. That proceeds of said sale in the amount of five thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$5,000.00) be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

- 1.0 PURPOSE: This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract for the sale of twenty-nine used transit vehicles.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: These transit vehicles, as identified in Attachment A to the resolution have exceeded the useful life criteria established by the Authority's Vehicle Replacement Policy and FTA regulations. These vehicles have deteriorated to such a degree that the cost to return them to a safe and reliable condition would far exceed their value. It was recommended that these vehicles not be repaired, but sold on an "as is" basis. Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43(k) authorizes the sale and disposition of property through full and open competition.
- 3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: Bid packages for the sales of fifty (50) vehicles were sent to 28 companies and/or individuals. Two bids were received by 2:00 p.m. on August 26, 2002. The bids are as listed on Attachment 1, Metal Management, Inc (MMI) bid one dollar each for 14 of the vehicles, and one hundred twenty-five dollars each for 29 other vehicles, seven (7) vehicles were not bid on. Transit Sales International (TSI) bid five thousand dollars for the same 29 vehicles as Metal Management Inc. It is in the best interest of the Authority to accept the bid of Transit Sales International for 29 vehicles at a lot price of five thousand dollars and reject the one dollar bid per vehicle submitted by Metal Management, Inc.
- 4.0 DBE/AFFIRMATIVE ACTION BACKGROUND: Does not apply.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: This disposal is consistent with the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Vehicle Replacement Policy and the Procurement Policy regarding the sale or disposal of property.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: The monies from this sale will be deposited into the General Fund.
- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: Reject all bids. Rejection of all bids will delay the sale of these used transit vehicles and cause the Authority to incur additional costs for storage.
- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the bid of Transit Sales International be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the General Manager to enter into a contract.
