

RESOLUTION NO. 2003-002

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2002-147 WITH ABRAMO CONSTRUCTION, INC., FOR PROJECT 9.96 –SOLON TRANSIT CENTER PAVEMENT REPAIRS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$35,000.00 (RTA CAPITAL FUND, PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the Authority deems it necessary to repair the damaged pavement at the Solon Transit Center as described under Project 9.96; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Abramo Construction, Inc., located at 9560 York Alpha Drive, North Royalton, Ohio 44133, for said repairs was received on December 30, 2002 in the amount of \$35,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Abramo Construction, Inc., to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for said repairs and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Abramo Construction, Inc., for Project 9.96 – Solon Transit Center Pavement Repairs, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Abramo Construction, Inc., for Project 9.96 – Solon Transit Center Pavement Repairs.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Capital Fund, Project Development & Engineering Department Budget, in the amount of thirty-five thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$35,000.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2002-120; bonding and insurance requirements; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.



- 1.0 PURPOSE: This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract for pavement repairs to the Solon Transit Center.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: This project resulted from damage caused by heavy transit coaches that use the bus route and bus shelter location at the Solon Commons. The work involves concrete repairs that will be carried out with minimal inconvenience to our customers, other users, and tenants. The concrete formula being used will allow cold weather work to proceed in order to expedite the completion of the project.
- 3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: Fifteen prospective bidders purchased packages for this Solicitation and 11 bids were received on December 30, 2002 as shown on Attachment A. A price analysis was performed and the Procurement Department determined the bid of Abramo Construction, Inc. to be fair and reasonable to the Authority. Abramo Construction, Inc. has completed many projects for RTA. Among them are the Oakwood and Westgate Comfort Stations and the Stokes Station Connecting Canopy. The project manager indicates they have done excellent work for the Authority. Due to the bids received and price range between high and low, a discussion was held with Abramo and their project manager indicated that their price was adequate for the required scope of work.
- 4.0 DBE/AFFIRMATIVE ACTION BACKGROUND: AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE COMPLIANCE: All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. Although there was no DBE goal established for this procurement, the prime contractor, Abramo Construction, Inc., North Royalton, Ohio is a RTA certified DBE (White Female) firm. Abramo will perform approximately 100% of the base contract work with its own forces.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: Does not apply.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: This procurement shall be payable from the RTA Capital Fund, Project Development & Engineering Department budget. The \$35,000.00 bid received from Abramo is \$6,100.00 (14.8%) below the engineer's estimate of \$41,100.00.

- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: Reject this bid. Rejection of this award will delay the needed repairs to the Solon Transit Center, impact safety at the location and the needs of our customers and other tenants at this location.
- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the bid of Abramo Construction, Inc., be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the General Manager to enter into a contract for Project 9.96-Solon Transit Center Pavement Repairs.
