

RESOLUTION 2003-060

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2003-018 WITH MUNCIE RECLAMATION AND SUPPLY FOR THE FURNISHING OF CHARGE AIR COOLERS, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$62,940.75 (GENERAL FUND, FLEET MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority requires the furnishing of charge air coolers for certain fixed route buses; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Muncie Reclamation and Supply located at 3720 S. Madison Street, Muncie, IN 47302 for the furnishing of charge air coolers, as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year was received on March 26, 2003, at unit prices resulting in an amount not to exceed sixty-two thousand nine hundred forty & 75/100 dollars (\$62,940.75); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Muncie Reclamation and Supply to be lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Muncie Reclamation and Supply received on March 26, 2003 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Muncie Reclamation and Supply for the furnishing of charge air coolers, as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the (General Fund, Fleet Management Department Budget), in an amount not to exceed sixty-two thousand nine hundred forty & 75/100 dollars (\$62,940.75).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, if any the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2002-120: bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
