- 1.0 PURPOSE/SCOPE: This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract for cleaning services for the Walkway to Gateway, as specified and as required on a requirement basis for a period of two (2) years.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: This project covers the custodial services at the Ronald J. Tober Walkway to Gateway on an as needed basis at each and every event and cleaning at periodic intervals of all elements of the specifications as specified. This contract enables the Authority to keep the Walkway clean to the benefit of our customers, employees, and the general image of the Authority.
- PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: Invitations for bid were sent to a total of twelve (12) prospective bidders. Bids were opened on July 10, 2003. There were four (4) bids submitted for this bid. Two of the bids were found to be non-responsive in that one did not have their required bid guaranty properly enclosed and the second did not have their bid page enclosed. A price analysis has been performed and the Procurement Department has determined the price to be fair and reasonable to the Authority.
