RESOLUTION 2004-13

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AUTHORIZING SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT NO. 2004-003 WITH ORACLE CORPORATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF ORACLE SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR AT A TOTAL COST OF \$279,395.22 (GENERAL FUND, INFORMATION SYSTEMS DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority currently utilizes several Oracle-licensed products for financial and human resource management applications; and

WHEREAS, annual maintenance and support is required to maintain these software applications; and

WHEREAS, said maintenance and support are only available through Oracle Corporation located at 500 Oracle Parkway, Redwood City, CA 94065, the original licensor of these systems; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43H(3) provides that competitive bidding is not required when the expenditure is for a renewal or re-negotiation or a lease or license for telecommunications or electronic data processing equipment, service or systems, or for the maintenance thereof as supplied by the original source or its successor or assigns; and

WHEREAS, Oracle Corporation has offered to provide said maintenance and support services at a negotiated price of two hundred seventy nine thousand three hundred ninety-five and 22/100 dollars (\$279,395.22) for a period of one year; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems acceptance of the offer of Oracle Corporation, as negotiated, to provide maintenance and support services for the Oracle Financials and Human Resource Management software programs to be advantageous to the Authority and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer of Oracle Corporation, as negotiated, to provide maintenance and support services for the Oracle Financials and Human Resource Management software programs for a period of one year be and the same is hereby accepted as in the best interest of the Authority.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Oracle Corporation to provide maintenance and support services for the Oracle Financials and Human Resource Management software programs for a period of one year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, Information Systems Department budget, at a total cost of two hundred seventy nine thousand three hundred ninety-five and 22/100 dollars (\$279,395.22) for a period of one year.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2003-107, bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects that Oracle Corporation will attempt to exceed the zero percent (0%) DBE goal assigned to this procurement.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

- 1.0 PURPOSE/SCOPE: This action will allow the Authority to obtain software upgrades and technical maintenance and support on various Oracle products for a period of one year.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: GCRTA has been utilizing the Oracle Applications since 1995. Annual maintenance and support is required to maintain the Oracle Financials and Human Resource Management software programs. The Oracle application is a proprietary product designed and maintained exclusively by the Oracle Corporation.
- 3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: This sole source contract for maintenance and support services is exempted from competitive bidding as authorized by Section 306.43H(3) of the Ohio Revised Code. After negotiations, Oracle Corporation offered to provide maintenance and support for the Oracle financials and human resource management software programs for a total price of \$279,395.22. This total price represents a discount from the rates listed in the State Cooperative Purchasing Agreement and are the same rates as charged last year. The increase in the total price from last year is due to additional applications the Authority has purchased and now require maintenance and support coverage.

The Information Systems Department reviewed the proposal for adherence to technical scope. A price analysis was performed and the Procurement Department has determined the negotiated price to be fair and reasonable to the Authority.

- 4.0 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND: All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 0% DBE goal was established for this procurement due to the lack of subcontracting opportunities.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: Does not apply.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: This contract will be funded through the General Fund, Information Systems Department budget at a total price of two hundred seventy nine thousand three hundred ninety-five and 22/100 dollars (\$279.395.22) for a period of one year.
- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: <u>Reject this award</u>. Rejection of this offer would leave the Oracle software programs without adequate maintenance and support.
- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the offer of Oracle Corporation, as negotiated be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the General Manager to enter into a contract.
