AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2004-030 WITH CARDINAL ASPHALT COMPANY FOR PROJECT - 10.41 SOUTHGATE PAVEMENT MODIFICATION & TRI-C EAST BUS PULL-OFF IN THE AMOUNT OF \$108,107.09 (RTA CAPITAL FUND, ENGINEERING & PROJECT DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

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WHEREAS, the Authority deems it necessary to modify pavement to provide additional parking that will accommodate two buses at the Southgate Transit Center and construct a bus-pull off at the Tri-C East Campus bus layover; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Cardinal Asphalt Company, located at 1380 Orlen Avenue, Cuyahoga Falls, for Project 10.41 – Southgate Pavement Modifications & Tri-C East Bus Pull-Off was received on April 5, 2004 in the amount of \$108,107.09; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the bid of Cardinal Asphalt Company, to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for said work and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Cardinal Asphalt Company. for Project 10.41 – Southgate Pavement Modification & Tri-C East Bus Pull-Off, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cardinal Asphalt Company, for Project 10.41 – Southgate Pavement Modification & Tri-C East Bus Pull-Off.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Capital Fund, Engineering & Project Development Department Budget, including but not limited to 100% local funds, in the amount of \$108,107.09.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda; if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2003-107; bonding and insurance requirements; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects that Cardinal Asphalt Company will exceed the 17% minimum DBE goal assigned to this procurement.

- 1.0 PURPOSE/SCOPE: This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract to modify pavement at the Southgate Transit Center parking lot and construct a bus-pull off at the Tri-C East Campus bus layover. This work will provide an additional lane that will accommodate increased traffic flow at Southgate and a bus pull off that can accommodate two buses at Tri-C East Campus.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: This project involves providing labor, material and equipment for removal and replacement of asphalt and concrete pavement, sidewalk, curbs, soil, trees and shrubs, per the contract documents. The bus pull off at Tri-C will improve passenger safety and traffic flow.
- 3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: Invitations for bids were issued to a total of eleven (11) prospective bidders. Six (6) bids were received on April 5, 2004 (See attachment A).

The Basis of Award is the lowest responsive bid received from a responsible bidder.

Cardinal Asphalt Company is currently performing similar work for the City of Hudson and the Stow Fire Station, Stow, Ohio. They have successfully completed parking lot improvements for Akron University, the City of Cuyahoga Falls and various projects for Home Depot.

The Procurement Department performed a price analysis and the \$108,107.09 bid submitted by Cardinal Asphalt Company is considered fair and reasonable.

4.0 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND: All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 17% DBE goal was established for this procurement. Cardinal Asphalt Company has committed to achieve the goal through the utilization of the following DBE firm(s):

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- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: Does not apply.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: This procurement will be funded from the RTA Capital Fund, Project Development & Engineering Department Budget, including but not limited to 100% local funds, in the amount of \$108,107.09. The Engineer's Estimate for this project is \$114,755.00. The bid price of \$108,107.09 is \$6,647.91 (6%) less than the Engineer's Estimate.
- 7.0 ALTERNATIVE: Reject this bid. Rejection of this award will delay providing needed additional parking for buses and an improved flow of bus traffic at Tri-C Campus.
- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the bid of Cardinal Asphalt Company be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the General Manager to enter into a contract for Project 10.41 Southgate Transit Center Parking Lot & Tri-C Bus Pull Off Pavement.
