AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2004-047 WITH STATEWIDE FORD LINCOLN-MERCURY INC., FOR THE FURNISHING OF THREE POLICE VEHICLES AS SPECIFIED THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AT A TOTAL PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$59,016.00 (RTA CAPITAL FUND - FLEET MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Authority has identified the need for three police vehicles to replace similar vehicles that have exceeded their useful life; and

WHEREAS, such vehicles are available through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

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WHEREAS, Division B of Section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code permits a regional transit authority to participate in contracts into which the state department of administrative services has entered for the purchase of supplies and services and Section 306.43(H)(4) of the Ohio Revised Code does not require competitive procedures in such case; and

WHEREAS, Section 306.43(H)(4) of the Ohio Revised Code permits trustees of a regional transit authority to enter into agreements with state participants in said program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees authorized utilization of the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program in Resolution 1990-69; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has deemed it in the best interest of the Authority to utilize the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program for the purchase of three police vehicles, as specified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

- Section 1. That the General Manager/Secretary Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Statewide Ford Lincoln-Mercury Inc., for the furnishing of three police vehicles, as specified.
- Section 2. That said contract is entered into under the authority granted by the Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43(H)(4).
- Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Capital Fund, Fleet Management Department budget at a total cost of fifty nine thousand, sixteen and 00/100 dollars (\$59,016.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2003-107; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

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Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

ACTION REQUEST:	

- 1.0 PURPOSE/SCOPE: This resolution will allow the Authority to enter into a contract with Statewide Ford Lincoln-Mercury Inc. for three police vehicles from the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: These vehicles will be marked patrol vehicles used by the Transit Police Department and will replace the vehicles listed below. These three vehicles have exceeded their useful life in accordance with the Authority's vehicle replacement policy and guidelines and will be removed from service.

3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: The vehicles will be purchased through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program. The unit cost of each vehicle is \$19,522.00. Manuals will also be provided at a cost of \$450.00. The total contract cost will be \$59,016.00.

The Board of Trustees has authorized the General Manager to utilize the State Cooperative Purchasing Program by Resolution 1990-69. The price established under the state program is the result of a competitive bidding process.

A cost analysis was performed by the Procurement Department and the price has been determined to be fair and reasonable to the Authority.

- 4.0 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND: The Office of Business Development does not conduct Affirmative Action reviews or establish goals on procurements included in the State Cooperative Purchasing program.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: Does not apply.
