AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2004-041 WITH DEMILTA IRON & METAL COMPANY FOR THE SALE OF FORTY EIGHT USED TRANSIT VEHICLES IN "AS IS" CONDITION FOR A TOTAL SALE PRICE OF THIRTY SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$36,576.00).

WHEREAS, forty eight (48) used transit vehicles have been determined to be obsolete in accordance with the Authority's vehicle replacement policy; and have been declared excess and to be disposed of in accordance with the Authority's property disposal procedure; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43(k) provides that a regional transit authority shall make a sale or other disposition of property through full and open competition; and

WHEREAS, the bids of two companies for the purchase of said vehicles were received on the 2nd day of June 2004; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the bids of DeMilta Iron & Metal Company to be the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for the items identified in Attachment A, hereto and recommend acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of DeMilta Iron & Metal Company located at 3950 Ben Hur Avenue, Willoughby, OH 44094, for the purchase of forty eight (48) used transit vehicles as listed on Attachment A, hereto for a total purchase price of thirty six thousand five hundred seventy six & 00/100 dollars (\$36,576.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with DeMilta Iron & Metal Company for forty eight (48) used transit vehicles as listed on Attachment A, hereto on such terms as are in the best interest of the Authority.

Section 3. That proceeds of said sale in the amount of thirty six thousand five hundred seventy six & 00/100 dollars (\$36,576.00) be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

- 1.0 PURPOSE: This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract for the sale of forty-eight (48) used transit vehicles.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: These transit vehicles, as identified in Attachment A to the resolution have exceeded the useful life criteria established by the Authority's Vehicle Replacement Policy and FTA regulations. These vehicles have deteriorated to such a degree that the cost to return them to a safe and reliable condition would far exceed their value. It was recommended that these vehicles not be repaired, but sold on an "as is" basis.
- 3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43(k) authorizes the sale and disposition of property through full and open competition.

Bid packages for the sale of forty-eight (48) used transit vehicles were sent to 39 companies and/or individuals. Two bids were received by 11:00 a.m. on June 2, 2004. The following is the summary of those bids:

DeMilta Iron & Metal Company bid

\$762.00 ea. X 48 =

\$36,576.00

Transit Sales International (TSI)

\$311.00 ea. X 48 =

\$14,928.00

The bid price of DeMilta Iron & Metal Company for the used transit vehicles is considered fair and reasonable.

- 4.0 DBE/AFFIRMATIVE ACTION BACKGROUND: The Office of Business Development does not conduct Affirmative Action reviews or establish goals on RTA procurements involving auction services or the sale of scrap or obsolete items.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: This disposal is consistent with the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Vehicle Replacement Policy and the Procurement Policy regarding the sale or disposal of property.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: The monies from this sale will be deposited into the General Fund.
- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: Reject all bids. Rejection of all bids will delay the sale of these used transit vehicles and cause the Authority to incur additional costs for storage.

- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the bid of DeMilta Iron & Metal Company be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer to enter into a contract.
- 9.0 ATTACHMENTS: None.
