BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

- Section 1. That transfers of funds may be made in this appropriation budget from one division to another or, within a division from one department to another or from one line item to another and shall be reported to the Board within thirty days after the end of the month in which said transfer occurred.
- Section 2. That as part of this appropriation, the General Manager is granted the authority to upgrade or downgrade positions within the Authority provided the total number of positions approved in the budget is not exceeded. Furthermore, the General Manager may transfer positions from one department to another so long as the total number of positions approved in the budget is not exceeded.
- Section 3. That the appropriation for the expenses and other expenditures and the approved staffing level of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority during the period of January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005, made by Resolution 2004-164, is hereby amended to read as attached in order that the amounts appropriated to each classification shall be not less than the amounts expended or encumbered in each classification during the fiscal year for which such appropriations are made and are hereby set aside and appropriated and that filled positions do not exceed the Board approved limit.
- Section 4. That the 2005 Annual Budget Appropriation and staffing be amended to read as per the attached pages which are incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this resolution as if set forth in their entirety.

<u>Section 5.</u> That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Trustees contingent upon Municipal approval of the proposed merger(s).
