RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND WATERFRONT DISTRICT PLAN

WHEREAS, in April 2002, Cleveland commenced a comprehensive lakefront planning process with an overall vision to shape the lakefront as the most vital element in the transformation of Cleveland as a place to live, work, and play; and

WHEREAS, over 5,000 public comments were received through a series of regional meetings, focused stakeholder discussions, small area planning charettes, and education forums; and

WHEREAS, a framework plan was developed from resident and stakeholder input that proposed an accessible waterfront, one that enhances the City of Cleveland as a great urban center, supporting a high quality of life for citizens and improving Cleveland's regional competitiveness in the global market place; and

WHEREAS, the new Greater Cleveland Waterfront District Plan yields an initial 3,000 acres for public enhancements through a systems based approach to infrastructure, parks, waterside, neighborhoods, and sustainable improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority supports the general goals of the Greater Cleveland Waterfront District Plan to:

- Improve and increase access to the lakefront for all citizens
- Improve the quality of amenities, activities, and urban design along the lakefront
- Promote development within the District to foster economic diversity, increase the city's tax base, and strengthen downtown as a regional center of economic activity
- Continue to enhance safety throughout the District
- Protect and enhance the natural systems and environmental quality of the District

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

<u>Section1.</u> That the Board of Trustees hereby endorses the Greater Cleveland Waterfront District Plan and its systems approach to leveraging waterfront improvements.

<u>Section 2.</u> The RTA Board of Trustees encourages the continued use of transit friendly design principals, and that public transit access, both to and along the waterfront, be integral to the project.

Section 3. That the Board of Trustees recognizes that greater collaboration on shoreline strategies and broadened waterfront districts will improve the region as we better protect, utilize, enhance, and celebrate the strength of Great Lake Erie and the Cuyahoga River Valley as Northeast Ohio's most powerful natural assets.

Section 4 That the Board of Trustees endorses the vision to shape the greater Cleveland waterfronts as quality places to live, work, and play, and as a result of this endorsement, this organization will further partner on waterfront strategies aimed at enhancing Northeast Ohio's overall regional competitiveness in the 21st century.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
