

RESOLUTION NO. 2005- 62

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2005-029 WITH ANIXTER, INC TO SUPPLY TEN (10) INTEGRAL DIGITAL RECORDERS IN A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$45,522.00 (RTA DEVELOPMENT FUND - TRANSIT POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the Authority has a requirement to purchase ten (10) Integral digital video recorders to install Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) at various RTA locations; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Anixter, Inc, with an office at 6400 West Snowville Rd., Brecksville, OH 44141, for the furnishing of this equipment was received on April 14, 2005, in a total amount of forty-five thousand five hundred twenty-two and 00/100 dollars (\$45,522.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the bid of Anixter, Inc to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Anixter, Inc for furnishing ten (10) Integral digital video recorders, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Anixter, Inc for furnishing ten (10) Integral digital video recorder units.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Development Fund, Transit Police Department budget in a total amount of forty-five thousand five hundred twenty-two and 00/100 dollars (\$45,522.00). These funds will be reimbursable through the 2004 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2005-51; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects Anixter, Inc. will attempt to exceed the 0% minimum DBE goal assigned to the Procurement.

- 1.0 PURPOSE: This action will allow the Authority to purchase ten (10) Digital video recorders in order to install Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) at various RTA locations.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: The Authority wishes to augment the security at various RTA locations. This is one of several approved CCTV projects that will be funded under the 2004 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program. Integral digital video recorders are readily available in the marketplace.
- 3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: Invitations for Bids were downloaded on the GCRTA web site by 11 prospective bidders for this solicitation. Four bids were received. Bids were opened on April 18, 2005 and the following are the results:

The offer of Anixter, Inc has been determined by the Procurement Department to be the lowest overall responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

A cost analysis has been performed and the Procurement Department had determined the price to be fair and reasonable to the Authority.

- 4.0 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND: All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 0% DBE goal was established for this procurement due to the lack of subcontracting opportunities

- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: Does not apply.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: This contract shall be funded through the RTA Development Fund, Transit Police Department budget in a total amount of forty-five thousand five hundred twenty-two and 00/100 dollars (\$45,522.00). Funds will be reimbursed under the 2004 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program. This price is 24% below the budget estimate of \$60,000.00.
- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: Rejection of this offer would leave the Authority without the ability to enhance security at various GCRTA locations.
- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the offer of Anixter, Inc. be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer to enter into a contract.
