AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2005-093 WITH CHEMICAL SOLVENTS, INC. TO PROVIDE PARTS WASH TANKS WITH CLEANING FLUID REPLACEMENT, AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS WITH A ONE-YEAR OPTION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$164,200.00 FOR THE BASE YEARS AND IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$82,100 FOR THE OPTION YEAR FOR A PROJECTED TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$246,300.00 (GENERAL FUND -- FLEET MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the Authority has a recurring requirement to provide parts wash tanks with cleaning fluid replacement in its day-to-day operations of vehicle maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the proposal of Chemical Solvents, Inc., located at 3751 Jennings Road, Cleveland, OH 44109 for providing such service was received on August 18, 2005; and

WHEREAS, after negotiations, Chemical Solvents, Inc. has offered to provide such services for a period of two years in an amount not to exceed one hundred sixty four thousand two hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$164,200.00) with a one-year option in an amount not to exceed eighty two thousand one hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$82,100.00) for a total projected contract amount not to exceed two hundred forty six thousand three hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$246,300.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the negotiated offer of Chemical Solvents, Inc. to be in the best interest of the Authority, price and other factors considered, and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer of Chemical Solvents, Inc. to provide parts wash tanks with cleaning fluid replacement, as required, for a period of two years, with a one- year option, be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Chemical Solvents, Inc. to provide said service for a period of two years, with the right to exercise the additional one year option.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the General Fund, Fleet Management Department budget in an amount not to exceed one hundred sixty four thousand two hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$164,200.00) for a period of two years with a one-year option in an amount not to exceed eighty two thousand one hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$82,100.00) for a total projected contract amount not to exceed two hundred forty six thousand three hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$246,300.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriation of funds for future years; compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2005-51; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects Chemical Solvents, Inc will attempt to exceed the 0% minimum DBE goal assigned to this procurement.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

- 1.0 PURPOSE: This action will allow the Authority to enter into a two-year contract for the furnishing of parts wash tanks with cleaning fluid, as required, with an option for one additional year.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: As a result of vehicle parts being cleaned and replaced, the Authority has a recurring need for parts wash tanks, cleaning solvents, tank cleaning and hazardous fluid waste removal and disposal.
- 3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: A Request for Proposal was posted on the GCRTA website and advertised in the local newspapers. Four potential vendors downloaded packages. On July 15, 2005, two proposals were received. After evaluation by a panel of Authority employees in accordance with established Procurement Policies and Procedures, and after negotiations, the proposal of Chemical Solvents, Inc. was selected as the most advantageous to the Authority. Chemical Solvents, Inc. is satisfactorily providing this service to the Authority under the current contract.

A cost/price analysis has been performed and the Procurement Department has determined the price to be fair and reasonable to the Authority.

- 4.0 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND: All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 0% DBE goal was established for this procurement due to the lack of certified DBE firms.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: Does not apply.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: This contract will be funded through the General Fund, Fleet Management Department budget in an amount not to exceed one hundred sixty four thousand two hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$164,200.00) for a period of two years with a one-year option in an amount not to exceed eighty two thousand one hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$82,100.00) for a total projected contract amount not to exceed two hundred forty six thousand three hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$246,300.00). The base contract cost is 5% below the estimate for this contract.
- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: Reject this Proposal. Rejection of the offer of Chemical Solvents, Inc. would affect the ability of the Authority to maintain a safe and hazard free repair facility.
