

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-222

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2006-124 WITH PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY, INC. FOR PROJECT NO. 11.22-REPAIRS TO LIFT #28 AT THE CENTRAL BUS MAINTENANCE FACILITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$54,200.00 (RTA CAPITAL FUND, ENGINEERING & PROJECT DEVELOPMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Authority deems it necessary to acquire construction services, as provided under Project 11.22 - Repairs to Lift #28 at the Central Bus Maintenance Facility; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. located at 525 Dan Street, Akron, Ohio 44310 was received on November 27, 2006 in the amount of \$54,200.00 to perform said services; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for said services and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. for Project 11.22, Repairs to Lift #28 at the Central Bus Maintenance Facility.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Capital Fund, Engineering & Project Development Department budget in the amount of fifty-four thousand two hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$54,200.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2006-077; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects that Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. will exceed the 15% DBE goal assigned to this procurement.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

1.0 **PURPOSE:** This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract to provide construction services for repairs to Lift #28 at the Central Bus Maintenance Facility, as specified under Project No. 11.22.

2.0 **DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION:** This project work involves the upgrading of Lift #28 (two-post hydraulic bus lift) at the Central Bus Maintenance Facility. The upgrades will include, but are not limited to, saw cutting the existing floor and sidewalks; demolition, removal and disposal of the concrete floors, walls and excavating soil; and furnishing and installing a new track and frame with integral reinforcements.

The existing lift is over 25 years old and is inoperable due to structural failure of the support wall and must be replaced by this upgrade.

3.0 **PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND:** This project is a re-bid. The previous bidding resulted in a single bid received. The one bid received far exceeded the Engineer's Estimate and the Invitation for Bid (IFB) was cancelled.

This solicitation was posted on the GCRTA Procurement web site and advertised in the local newspapers. Invitations for Bid packages were requested by a total of five prospective bidders. Three (3) bids were received and opened on November 28, 2006, as follows:

The Basis of Award was to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder of the Total Base Bid (Lump Sum Price). Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. successfully completed the Authority's West Park Parking Lot Sealing project and has also installed machine pits at Collins & Aikman GMT, Canton, Ohio.

A price analysis was performed and the Procurement Department determined the bid price to be fair and reasonable to the Authority.

4.0 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND: All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 15% DBE goal was established for this procurement. Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. has committed to meet the DBE goal through the utilization of McTech in an amount of at least \$8,130.00.

5.0 POLICY IMPACT: None

6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: This procurement will be funded from the RTA Capital Fund, Engineering & Project Development Department budget in the amount of fifty-four thousand two hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$54,200.00). The Total Base Bid price of \$54,200.00 was 8% below the Engineer's Estimate of \$58,945.00.

7.0 ALTERNATIVES: Reject this bid. Rejection of all bids would delay the Authority's ability to prevent further improvements at the Central Bus Maintenance Facility.

8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer to enter into a contract.
