

RESOLUTION 2007-116

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2007-069 WITH W.W. WILLIAMS MIDWEST, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF DETROIT DIESEL SERIES 50 EGR ENGINE PART KITS, AS SPECIFIED, AT A TOTAL PRICE OF \$191,975.00 (GENERAL FUND, FLEET MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Authority has a recurring need to repair and rebuild Detroit Diesel engines on the Authority's coaches; and

WHEREAS, the bid of W. W. Williams Midwest, Inc., located at 1176 Industrial Parkway, N. Brunswick, Ohio 44212 for the purchase of thirty-five (35) Detroit Diesel Series 50 EGR Engine Part Kits, as specified, at a total price of one hundred ninety-one thousand nine hundred seventy-five & 00/100 dollars (\$191,975.00) was received on August 1, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the bid of W.W. Midwest, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of W.W. Williams Midwest, Inc., for the purchase of Detroit Diesel Series 50 EGR Engine Part Kits be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with W.W. Williams Midwest, Inc. for the purchase of Detroit Diesel Series 50 EGR Engine Part Kits, as specified.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the General Fund, Fleet Management Department budget, at a total price of one hundred ninety-one thousand nine hundred seventy-five & 00/100 dollars (\$191,975.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority, contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda; if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2007-064 bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects that W.W. Williams Midwest, Inc. will attempt to exceed the 0% minimum DBE goal assigned to this procurement.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

- 1.0 **PURPOSE/SCOPE:** This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract for the purchase of Detroit Diesel Series 50 EGR Engine Part Kits, as specified.
- 2.0 **DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION:** This procurement is needed for the repair and rebuild of thirty-five (35) Detroit Diesel engine kits on the Authority's 2200 NABI fleet of coaches equipped with these engines.
- 3.0 **PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND:** The Invitation for Bid was posted on the GCRTA Procurement web site and advertised in the local newspapers. Two (2) bids were received on August 1, 2007 as follows:



The bid of W.W. Williams Midwest, Inc. has been determined by the Procurement Department to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder. A price analysis has been performed and the Procurement Department has determined the price to be fair and reasonable to the Authority.

- 4.0 **AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND:** All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 0% DBE goal was established for this procurement due to the lack of certified DBE firms.
- 5.0 **POLICY IMPACT:** Does not apply:
- 6.0 **ECONOMIC IMPACT:** This procurement will be funded through the General Fund, Fleet Management Department budget, at a total price of one hundred ninety-one thousand nine hundred seventy-five & 00/100 dollars (\$191,975.00). The bid price is approximately 6% below the \$205,000.00 estimated cost for this procurement.
- 7.0 **ALTERNATIVES:** Reject all bids. Rejection of this offer would cause delays in the procurement of the engines and possibly affect the Authority's pull out schedule for the fleet of coaches.

- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the bid of W.W. Williams Midwest, Inc. be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer to enter into a contract.
- 9.0 ATTACHMENTS: None.
