AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2007-089 WITH DIESEL RADIATOR COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF RADIATOR CORES, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$58,340.00 (GENERAL FUND, FLEET MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Authority has a recurring need to replace radiator cores which are no longer serviceable; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Diesel Radiator Company located at 1985 Janice Avenue, Melrose Park, IL 60160 for the furnishing of radiator cores, as specified and as required, for a period of one (1) year in an amount not to exceed \$58,340.00 was received on September 19, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the bid of Diesel Radiator Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:
- Section 1. That the bid of Diesel Radiator Company for the furnishing of radiator cores be and the same is hereby accepted.
- Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Diesel Radiator Company for the furnishing of radiator cores, as specified and as required, for a period of one (1) year.
- Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the General Fund, Fleet Management Department budget, in an amount not to exceed fifty-eight thousand three hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$58,340.00)
- Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda; if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2007-064; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.
- Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects that Diesel Radiator Company will attempt to exceed the 0% minimum DBE goal assigned to this procurement.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

- 1.0 PURPOSE/SCOPE: This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract for radiator cores, as specified on a requirement basis for a period of one (1) year.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: This is a recurring procurement for radiator cores to be used in GCRTA Coaches, Paratransit and Maintenance Vehicles for replacement of units that are no longer serviceable or maintainable.
- 3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: The Invitation for Bid (IFB) was posted on the GCRTA Procurement web site and advertised in the local newspapers. Three (3) bids were received on September 19, 2007. This was a divisible bid with three (3) line items; therefore, an individual comparison for each line item was made. A summary of the three (3) bids are as follows:

The bid of Diesel Radiator Company has been determined by the Procurement Department to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for items 1 and 3. The bid of Prevost Parts for item 2 will be awarded under the General Manager's small purchase Authority.

A price analysis has been performed and the Procurement Department has determined the price to be fair and reasonable to the Authority.

- 4.0 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND: All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 0% DBE Goal was established for this procurement due to lack of subcontracting opportunities.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: Does not apply:
