## RESOLUTION NO. 2009-99

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2009-132A WITH MAGNADATA USA, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF MAGNETIC FARE MEDIA CARDS (TRIM ISSUED), AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS, WITH TWO ONE YEAR OPTIONS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$163,125.00 FOR THE BASE TERM AND IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$54,375.00 FOR EACH OPTION YEAR FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$271,875.00 (GENERAL FUND, REVENUE DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority dispenses magnetic paper thermal cards from the GFI electronic fareboxes; and

WHEREAS, this procurement was divided into three sections and the vendors were able to bid on one or any combination of the sections; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Magnadata USA, Inc., located at 100 Route 70, Suite 9; Lakewood, NJ 08701, for the furnishing of magnetic paper thermal cards, as required, was received on October 5, 2009, at unit prices resulting in an amount not to exceed one hundred sixty-three thousand one hundred twenty-five & 00/100 dollars (\$163,125.00) for the base years and in an amount not to exceed fifty-four thousand three hundred seventy-five & 00/100 dollars (\$54,375.00) for each option year for a total contract amount not to exceed two hundred seventy-one thousand eight hundred seventy-five & 00/100 dollars (\$271,875.00) for Section 1; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the bid of Magnadata USA, Inc. to be the lowest bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Magnadata USA, Inc, Inc be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest bid from a responsible bidder for magnetic paper thermal cards.

Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Magnadata USA, Inc for the furnishing of magnetic paper thermal cards, as required, for the base period of three (3) years with the authority to exercise the option for two (2) additional one (1) year periods.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, Revenue Department budget in an amount not to exceed one hundred sixty-three thousand one hundred twenty-five & 00/100 dollars (\$163,125.00) for the base years and in an amount not to exceed fifty-four thousand three hundred seventy-five & 00/100 dollars (\$54,375.00) for each option year for a total contract amount not to exceed two hundred seventy-one thousand eight hundred seventy-five & 00/100 dollars (\$271,875.00).

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Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriation of funds for future years; compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2009-023; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

- 1.0 PURPOSE/SCOPE: This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract with Magnadata USA, Inc. for the purchase of fare media cards, as required, for a period of three years with two one year options.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: The Authority requires paper thermal magnetic strip cards that are issued with the GFI Electronic fareboxes installed on RTA vehicles fleetwide. These cards may be press printed with RTA graphics or other promotional graphics as required by RTA.
- 3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: The Invitation For Bid (IFB) was posted on the GCRTA Procurement web site and advertised in the local newspapers. Sixteen prospective bidders accessed and/or downloaded the solicitation and three bids were received. The IFB was divided into three sections and the vendors were able to bid on one or any combination of the sections. Each bidder was requested to provide samples of each type of magnetic cards to be tested by the GCRTA Revenue Department to ensure they were compatible with the GFI Genfare TriM card readers. Magnadata USA, Inc. was determined to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder on Section 1 as shown in the attached summary of bids.
- 4.0 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND: All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A. 0% DBE goal was established for this procurement due to the lack of certified DBE firms.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: Does not apply.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: This procurement will be funded through the General Fund, Revenue Department budget in an amount not to exceed one hundred sixty-three thousand one hundred twenty-five & 00/100 dollars (\$163,125.00) for the base contract and in an amount not to exceed fifty-four thousand three hundred seventy-five & 00/100 dollars (\$54,375.00) for each option year for a total amount not to exceed two hundred seventy-one thousand eight hundred seventy-five & 00/100 dollars (\$271,875.00) for the contract amount . This amount is 4% less than the cost estimate of \$283,875.00.
- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: <u>Reject this offer</u>. Rejection of this offer would prevent the sale of all day passes on board vehicles from the GFI Electronic fareboxes.
- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the bid of Magnadata USA, Inc. be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer to enter into a contract.
