AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF GRANT APPLICATIONS WITH THE NORTHEAST OHIO AREAWIDE COORDINATING AGENCY FOR STATE FISCAL YEARS 2011, 2012 AND 2013 FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND CAPITAL PROJECTS UNDER ALL NORTHEAST OHIO AREAWIDE COORDINATING AGENCY PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is a federally designated funding recipient; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is providing transit service, implementing a capital program, and observing all federal and state rules regarding these programs.

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:
- Section 1. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer is hereby authorized to file applications as required and execute contracts on behalf of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority with NOACA for financial assistance and capital project programs (including by transfer of highway funds) under all NOACA programs.
- Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer is authorized to execute and file such applications, any assurances or any other documentation required by NOACA under the financial assistance and capital project programs.
- Section 3. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer is authorized to furnish such additional information as NOACA may require in connection with these applications.
- Section 4. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is authorized to accept the funds resulting from the NOACA financial assistance and capital project programs.
- Section 5. That, in the absence of the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer, the Acting General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is hereby authorized to perform any and all of the above-described functions.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
