

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-24

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER/SECRETARY-TREASURER TO ENTER INTO AN INTER-AGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF CLEVELAND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE CITY TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL TWO (2) BUS SHELTERS IN THE VICINITY OF THE MARKET SQUARE PARK AT WEST 25TH STREET AND LORAIN AVENUE AS PART OF GCRTA'S TRANSIT WAITING ENVIRONMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland ("City") is designing and implementing the construction of improvements to the Market Square Park at the intersection of West 25th Street and Lorain Avenue in the City of Cleveland; and

WHEREAS, the GCRTA provides public transportation in the City and is involved in a transit area waiting enhancement program; and

WHEREAS, Market Square Park is a busy bus transfer point within RTA's transit network, providing transfer between multiple bus lines and the W. 25th Street Rapid Transit Station; and

WHEREAS, the GCRTA and the City wish to enhance the safety and aesthetics of waiting areas for transit passengers in the Market Square Park area; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to purchase and install two new bus shelters on West 25th Street and Lorain Avenue while causing the improvements to Market Square Park; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is paying the City \$92,000 to purchase and install two (2) bus shelters that have components which are compatible with the Authority's Transit Zone shelter components; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has approved the design and will own and maintain the shelters; and

WHEREAS, the Authority will install two signs as part of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority hereby authorizes an Inter-Agency Agreement with the City of Cleveland to purchase and install two (2) bus shelters for the Market Square Park.

Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into and Inter-Agency Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. That this contract is payable from the Development Fund, Planning & Programming Department budget, including but not limited to Capital Formula Grant OH-90-X531 in the amount of \$92,000 (\$73,600 in Federal Funds which represents 80% of the total cost).

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

**INTER-AGENCY AGREEMENT
FOR
MARKET SQUARE PARK IMPROVEMENTS**

BETWEEN

**THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY
AND
THE CITY OF CLEVELAND**

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2012, by and between THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY (hereinafter designated "GCRTA"), a Regional Transit authority and political subdivision of the State of Ohio pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 306.35, pursuant to the authority of GCRTA Resolution No. 2012- _____ adopted on _____, and the CITY OF CLEVELAND (hereinafter designated the "City"), a political subdivision of the State of Ohio, through its Director of Public Works, pursuant to the authority of Ordinance No. 600-11, passed May 23, 2011.

WHEREAS, the City is designing and implementing the construction of improvements to Market Square Park; and

WHEREAS, the GCRTA provides public transportation in the City and is involved in a transit area waiting enhancement program; and

WHEREAS, the GCRTA and the City wish to enhance the safety and aesthetics of waiting areas for transit passengers in the area of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the CITY has agreed to purchase and install two new bus shelters on West 25th Street and Lorain Avenue (hereinafter designated the "Project") while causing the improvements to Market Square Park, and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The GCRTA has reviewed and approved the Project design provided by the City and any modifications thereto.
2. The City shall purchase and install two new bus shelters, shelter foundations and pads and electrical conduit for the Project on West 25th Street and Lorain Avenue in the vicinity of Market Square Park (hereinafter "Shelters") substantially in conformity with the plans and drawings attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A" which plans and drawings may be subject to further modification and approval by the mutual agreement of the parties. In compensation for the City's purchase and installation of these items for the Project GCRTA shall pay to the City a total sum not to exceed Ninety-two Thousand Dollars (\$92,000.00).

3. GCRTA shall pay amounts invoiced by City contractors within thirty (30) days of GCRTA approval of the invoices.
4. The City shall be solely responsible for any and all costs incurred for purchase and installation of the Shelters or related to the Project over and above the amount stated in Section 2. above. If any changes in the Project are requested by GCRTA in writing and such changes cause the costs of any portion of the Project to increase over the originally budgeted or agreed-to amounts, GCRTA shall only be responsible for increases to the extent that they were incurred after the City received express written approval from GCRTA and GCRTA's obligation therefore was authorized by GCRTA's General Manager or Board of Trustees in accordance with GCRTA's policies and procedures.
5. The City and GCRTA acknowledge that funding for GCRTA's portion of the Project cost may be provided by grants from the Federal Transit Administration, and that all requirements in connection therewith shall be incorporated in the Project as applicable. All FTA mandated terms and conditions shall be included in all Project contracts.
6. The City agrees to construct the Project in such manner as to prevent or minimize any disruption to GCRTA's bus service. Any such planned disruption to bus service shall be subject to GCRTA's concurrence and the provision of sufficient advance notice (at least thirty days) to GCRTA to permit it to plan and provide alternative service and advance notice thereof to the riding public.
7. The title to the bus shelters shall vest in GCRTA once the Project is complete, and the City grants GCRTA a license to maintain the bus shelters commencing upon their installation on the City's property for a term of one year or upon execution of an easement authorizing the same, whichever occurs first.



- 1.0 PURPOSE/SCOPE: This resolution authorizes the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer to execute an Inter-Agency Agreement with the City of Cleveland to pay the City Ninety-two thousand dollars (\$92,000.00) to purchase and install two (2) bus shelters in the vicinity of the Market Square Park Improvements. This is being done as part of the Transit Waiting Environment Program (TWE). It is also a vital piece of the upgrade of the park being completed to celebrate the West Side Market's birthday.
- 2.0 DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION: The City of Cleveland ("City") is making improvements to the Market Square Park at the intersection of West 25th Street and Lorain Avenue in the City of Cleveland. GCRTA would like to work with the City to enhance the safety and aesthetics of waiting areas for transit passengers in the Market Square Park area. The City has agreed to purchase and install two new bus shelters as a part of the improvements to Market Square Park. These shelters are compatible with the Authority's Transit Zone shelter components. GCRTA has approved the design and will own and maintain the shelters. As part of the project, GCRTA has also agreed to install two (2) signs.
- 3.0 PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND: Does Not Apply.
- 4.0 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND: Does Not Apply.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: The project is consistent with GCRTA's Transit Waiting Environment program and will enhance the safety and aesthetics of the waiting area at West 25th Street and Lorain Avenue in the City of Cleveland.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: This contract will be paid from the Development Fund, Planning & Programming Department budget, including but not limited to Capital Formula Grant OH-90-X531 in the amount of Ninety-two thousand dollars (\$73,600 in Federal Funds, which represent 80% of the total cost).
- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: If this resolution were not approved, RTA would not be able to enter into this Inter-Agency Agreement to install the bus shelters to enhance the safety and aesthetics of waiting areas for transit passengers in the Market Square Park area. This project will alleviate over-crowding of the existing shelters and provide real-time data to the many passengers using these stops.
