

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-95

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2014-056 WITH THE GOODYEAR TIRE & RUBBER COMPANY FOR FURNISHING TIRE AND WHEEL MAINTENANCE SERVICES AND FOR THE LEASING OF RADIAL TIRES, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS AT A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,584,021.01 (GENERAL FUND, FLEET MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has a need to service and provide wheels and tubeless radial tires on all of its revenue vehicles; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined to be cost effective for the Authority to lease this service as opposed to procuring, maintaining tire inventory and staffing personnel to service the Authority's tires; and

WHEREAS, the proposal of The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, with offices at 200 Innovation Way, Akron, OH 44316, as negotiated for tire and wheel maintenance services and leasing of radial tires for a period of five (5) years, as specified and as required, was received on June 25, 2014, and

WHEREAS, after negotiations, The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, has offered to provide such services in an approximate amount not to exceed \$5,584,021.01; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the proposal of The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company to be most favorable to the Authority, cost and all other factors considered, and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal of The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company as negotiated, for tire and wheel maintenance services and leasing of radial tires for a period of five (5) years, as specified and as required, be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company for tire and wheel maintenance services and leasing of radial tires for a period of five (5) years, as specified and as required.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the General Fund, Fleet Management Department Budget, in an approximate amount not to exceed \$5,584,021.01 for a period of five (5) years.


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriation for the current and future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2009-023; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects that The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company will attempt to exceed the 0% minimum DBE goal assigned to this procurement.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption

1.0 **PURPOSE/SCOPE:** This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract for tire and wheel maintenance services and leasing of radial tires for a five (5) year period, as specified and as required, for the Authority's revenue vehicles.

2.0 **DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION:** A lease vs buy analysis has been performed, in accordance with Procurement Department Policies and Procedures and the Authority has determined it to be cost effective to contract for the leasing services of tubeless radial tires. Most transit authorities have similar arrangements for their revenue tire needs.

Contracting out the maintenance and leasing of tires has proven to be beneficial to the Authority. The contractor maintains a sufficient inventory for all the Authority's tubeless radial tires and provides on-site service at each of the Authority's district garages. This leasing arrangement allows the contractor to maintain title of the tires, which relieves the Authority of any EPA responsibility for the disposal of tires.

3.0 **PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND:** Requests for Proposal were sent to the three (3) known providers of lease and tire service. Three (3) proposals were received on June 25, 2014. After evaluation by a panel of Authority employees in accordance with established Procurement Department Policies and Procedures, and negotiations, the proposal of The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company for tire and wheel maintenance services and leasing of radial tires as specified and as required for a period of (5) years was determined to be the most favorable to the Authority, price and all other factors considered.

4.0 **AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND:** All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 0% DBE goal was established for this procurement due to the lack of certified DBE firms.

5.0 **POLICY IMPACT:** Does not apply.

6.0 **ECONOMIC IMPACT:** This procurement will be funded through the General Fund, Fleet Management Department budget, in an approximate amount not to exceed \$5,584,021.01 for a period of five (5) years. This is a 28% decrease of the budgeted amount for this purchase.

- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: Reject this award. Rejection of this offer would impact the Authority ability to replace worn tires and wheels, which could impact the safety and service of the Authority.
- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the proposal of Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, as negotiated, be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer to enter into a contract.
- 9.0 ATTACHMENTS: None.
