

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-119

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2014-160 WITH EVAN CORPORATION DBA EVAN FALL PROTECTION SYSTEMS, INC. FOR PROJECT 15.71 – FALL PROTECTION FOR PAINTING & SANDING BOOTHS AT CBMF, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$105,000.00 (RTA DEVELOPMENT FUND, ENGINEERING & PROJECT DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Authority deems it necessary to acquire construction services, as provided under Project 15.71 – Fall Protection for Painting & Sanding Booths at CBMF; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Evan Corporation DBA Evan Fall Protection Systems, Inc., located at 3125 Industrial Dr., Sanford, North Carolina 27332, was received on November 19, 2014 in an amount not to exceed \$105,000.00 to perform said services; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the bid of Evan Corporation DBA Evan Fall Protection Systems, Inc., to be a responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Evan Corporation DBA Evan Fall Protection Systems, Inc., for Project 15.71 – Fall Protection for Painting & Sanding Booths at CBMF be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Evan Corporation DBA Evan Fall Protection Systems, Inc., for Project 15.71 – Fall Protection for Painting & Sanding Booths at CBMF.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Development Fund, Engineering & Project Development Department budget, including but not limited to, Capital Grant OH-90-X782, in an amount of \$105,000.00 (\$84,000.00 in Federal funds which represents 80% of the total cost.)


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon future funding, compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2013-31; bonding and insurance requirements; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects that Evan Corporation DBA Evan Fall Protection Systems, Inc. will attempt to exceed the 10% minimum DBE goal assigned to this procurement.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

- 1.0 **PURPOSE/SCOPE:** This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract to provide construction services for Project 15.71 Fall Protection for Painting & Sanding Booths at CBMF.
- 2.0 **DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION:** This project consists of the design, fabrication and installation of trolley beam fall arrest systems at various locations in the Central Bus Maintenance Facility including but not limited to the painting booths, sanding booths and over existing bus lifts; and to provide personal protective equipment including body harnesses, D-rings, SLR's and tag lines.
- 3.0 **PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND:** The Invitation for Bid (IFB) was posted on the GCRTA Procurement website and advertised in the local newspaper. Nineteen prospective bidders downloaded the solicitation package. Three bids were received and opened on November 19, 2014, as follows:

Hy-Safe Technology	\$106,705.00
Diversified Fall Protection	\$119,089.00

The Basis of Award is the lowest responsive and responsible bid for the Total Base Bid/Lump Sum Price. The Total Base Bid price of \$105,000.00 from Evan Corporation DBA Evan Fall Protection Systems, Inc. is 44.60% less than the Engineer's Estimate of \$189,531.30. Evan Corporation DBA Evan Fall Protection Systems, Inc. was determined to be a responsible bidder.

- 4.0 **AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND:** All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 10% DBE goal was established for this procurement. Evan Fall Protection Systems Inc., has committed to achieve the goal through the utilization of ProFab, Inc. (Female-owned) in the amount of \$10,800 or 10.3%.
- 5.0 **POLICY IMPACT:** Does not apply.
- 6.0 **ECONOMIC IMPACT:** This procurement shall be payable through the RTA Development Fund, Engineering & Project Development Department budget, including but not limited to, Capital Grant OH-90-X782, Line item 11.42.20 in an amount of \$105,000.00 (\$84,000.00 in Federal funds which represents 80% of the total cost).
- 7.0 **ALTERNATIVES:** Reject this offer. Rejection of this offer will not provide the required additional trolley beam fall arrest systems to enhance the safety of RTA employees at various locations in the Central Bus Maintenance Facility.
