NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That a new Section 4 is hereby added after Section 3 of Resolution No. 2013-49 that reads as follows: "Section 4. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority will provide the local match amount for any grant awarded to it by NOACA for State fiscal years 2015 and 2016."

Section 2. That Sections 4, 5 and 6 of Resolution No. 2013-49 are hereby re-numbered as Sections 5, 6 and 7, respectively.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

- Section 3. That the General Manager/Secretary -Treasurer is authorized to furnish such additional information as NOACA may require in connection with these applications.
- Section 4. That the General Manager/Secretary -Treasurer of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is authorized to accept the funds resulting from the NOACA financial assistance and capital project programs.
- Section 5. That, in the absence of the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer, the Acting General Manager/Secretary -Treasurer of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is hereby authorized to perform any and all of the above-described functions.
