

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-51

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2016-058 WITH STANDARD CONTRACTING & ENGINEERING, INC. FOR PROJECT 16.51 – EAST 9TH STREET STATION STAIR REPLACEMENT, AS SPECIFIED, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$105,900.00 (RTA CAPITAL FUND, ENGINEERING & PROJECT DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Authority deems it necessary to acquire construction services, as provided under Project 16.51 – East 9th Street Station Stair Replacement; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Standard Contracting & Engineering, Inc., located at 6356 Eastland Road, Brook Park, Ohio 44142, was received on May 25, 2016 in an amount not to exceed \$105,900.00 to perform said services; and

WHEREAS, the CEO, General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the bid of Standard Contracting & Engineering, Inc., to be a responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Standard Contracting & Engineering, Inc., for Project 16.51 – East 9th Street Station Stair Replacement be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the CEO, General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Standard Contracting & Engineering, Inc., for Project 16.51 – East 9th Street Station Stair Replacement.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Capital Fund, Engineering & Project Development Department budget, including but not limited to, 100% Local, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$105,900.00.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2015-76; bonding and insurance requirements; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects that Standard Contracting & Engineering, Inc. will attempt to exceed the 10% minimum DBE goal assigned to this procurement.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

- 1.0 **PURPOSE/SCOPE:** This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract to provide construction services for Project 16.51, East 9th Street Station Stair Replacement.
- 2.0 **DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION:** This project is located at GCRTA's East 9th Street Station, 1181 East 9th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44114. This project involves the demolition and replacement of existing concrete filled metal stair pans with new concrete filled stainless steel stair pans. This includes reconditioning and painting the existing steel stringers at each stair along with removing and reinstalling the existing fiberglass tread covers.
- 3.0 **PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND:** The Invitation for Bid ("IFB") was posted on the GCRTA Procurement website and advertised in the local newspaper. Ten (10) interested parties downloaded the solicitation package and two (2) responsive bids were received and opened on May 25, 2016, as follows:


Company Name	Total Base Bid
Standard Contracting & Engineering, Inc.	\$105,900.00
EnviroCom Construction, Inc.	\$116,000.00

The Basis of Award is the lowest responsive and responsible bid for the Total Base Bid/Lump Sum Price. The base bid price of \$105,900.00 from Standard Contracting & Engineering, Inc. is approximately 1% below the Engineer's Estimate of \$109,600.00. Standard Contracting & Engineering, Inc. was determined to be a responsible bidder.

- 4.0 **AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND:** All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 10% DBE goal was established for this procurement. Standard Contracting & Engineering has committed to achieving the DBE participation goal through the utilization of Denise's Flaggging (Female-owned) in the amount of \$16,240.00 and Rockport Readymix (Female-owned) in the amount of \$538.00 for a total of \$16,778.00 or 15.8%.
- 5.0 **POLICY IMPACT:** Does not apply.
- 6.0 **ECONOMIC IMPACT:** This contract shall be payable from the RTA Capital Fund, Engineering & Project Development Department budget, including but not limited to, 100% Local Funds, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$105,900.00.
- 7.0 **ALTERNATIVES:** Reject this offer. Rejection of this offer will allow further deterioration of the stairs at this station.
- 8.0 **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the bid of Standard Contracting & Engineering, Inc. be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the CEO, General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer to enter into a contract.
