EXPRESSING THE GREAT SORROW OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND THE ENTIRE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY AT THE PASSING OF FORMER U.S. CONGRESSMAN STEVEN LATOURETTE AND EXTENDING CONDOLENCES TO HIS FAMILY

WHEREAS, Congressman Steven LaTourette dedicated his life to public service, working tirelessly to improve the quality of life for his Ohio constituency; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Steven LaTourette served Northeastern Ohio with distinction, representing Ohio's 19<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Congressional Districts from 1995 to 2013; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Steven LaTourette served as Lake County Prosecutor from 1989 to 1995 and as a public defender; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Steven LaTourette was a member of the Republican Main Street Partnership. He co-wrote the Financial Data Protection Act of 2006 to improve banking and privacy laws; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Steven LaTourette was well known for his bipartisanship and support of funding infrastructure projects, which included roads, bridges and RTA's award-winning HealthLine Bus Rapid Transit.


