

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-21

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2017-168 WITH BLD DOOR SERVICE, LLC, DBA OVERHEAD DOOR COMPANY OF AKRON, FOR OVERHEAD DOOR REPAIR, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$360,000.00 (GENERAL FUND, SERVICE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority requires recurring services for repair and maintenance of the Authority's overhead doors at various facilities; and

WHEREAS, the bid of BLD Door Service, LLC, dba Overhead Door Company of Akron, located at 1750 Newberry Street, Cuyahoga Falls, OH 44221, for the furnishing of overhead door repair services, as specified and as required, for a period of three years, was received on January 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the CEO, General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the bid of BLD Door Service, LLC, dba Overhead Door Company of Akron, to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of BLD Door Service, LLC, dba Overhead Door Company of Akron, for overhead door repair services, as specified and as required, be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the CEO, General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with BLD Door Service, LLC, dba Overhead Door Company of Akron for the furnishing of overhead door repair services, as specified and as required, for a period of three years.

Section 3. That said contract shall be funded through the General Fund, Service Management Department budget, in an amount not to exceed \$360,000.00 for a period of three years.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon funding for future years and compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 2015-076; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects that BLD Door Service, LLC, dba Overhead Door Company of Akron, will attempt to exceed the 0% minimum DBE goal assigned to this procurement.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


- 1.0 **PURPOSE/SCOPE:** This action will allow the Authority to enter into a contract for overhead door repair and maintenance services at various facilities throughout the Authority, as specified and as required, for a period of three years.
- 2.0 **DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION:** This project provides service to repair and maintain the overhead doors at various facilities across the Authority due to damage from accidents, as well as failures from age and normal wear. This service maintains the security of the Authority's buildings and equipment, as well as prevents employees and assets from being exposed to inclement weather.
- 3.0 **PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND:** The Invitation for Bid ("IFB") was posted on the procurement web site and advertised in the local newspapers. Notifications were sent to five potential vendors. Four interested parties downloaded the solicitation from the web site. Two responsive bids from responsible bidders were opened January 31, 2018. A summary is as follows:

The bid of BLD Door Service, LLC, dba Overhead Door Company of Akron has been determined by the Procurement Department to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder. The contract will include both material and labor, at the labor rates contained in the bid document. The "not to exceed" amount is based on the average cost incurred on both material and labor over the past three years, resulting in an estimated annual cost of \$120,000.00, for a three year total not to exceed \$360,000.00. A price analysis was performed and the Procurement Department has determined the price to be fair and reasonable to the Authority.

- 4.0 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND: All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 0% DBE goal was established for this procurement due to the lack of certified DBE firms.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: Does not apply.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: This procurement will be funded through the General Fund, Service Management Department budget, in an amount not to \$360,000.00 at the hourly rates established for a period of three years. The hourly rates bid for the contract have decreased for one and two repairman by approximately 3.3% and 5.2%, respectively, from the previous contract pricing.
- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: Reject this offer. Rejection of this offer would delay the continued repair and maintenance service required on the Authority's overhead doors, potentially exposing the Authority's employees and assets to financial and safety risks.
- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the bid of BLD Door Service, LLC, dba Overhead Door Company of Akron, be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the CEO, General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer to enter into a contract.
