

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-63

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2019-066 WITH OHIO MACHINERY CO., INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF REMANUFACTURED CATERPILLAR C-9 FUEL INJECTORS, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$314,372.90 (GENERAL FUND, FLEET MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority requires the replacement of Caterpillar C-9 injectors as required; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Ohio Machinery Co., Inc., located at 3993 East Royalton Road, Broadview Heights, OH 44147, for the furnishing of remanufactured Caterpillar C-9 fuel injectors, as specified and as required, for a period of three years, was received on May 29, 2019 at unit prices resulting in a total contract amount not to exceed \$314,372.90; and

WHEREAS, the Interim CEO, General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer deems the bid of Ohio Machinery Co., Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Ohio Machinery Co., Inc. for the furnishing of remanufactured Caterpillar C-9 fuel injectors, as specified and as required, for a period of three years be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the Interim CEO, General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ohio Machinery Co., Inc. for the furnishing of remanufactured Caterpillar C-9 fuel injectors, as specified and as required, for a period of three years.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the General Fund, Fleet Management Department budget, in an amount not to exceed \$314,372.90 for a period of three years.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon funding for future years and compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 2015-076; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Board of Trustees expects that Ohio Machinery Co., Inc. will attempt to exceed the 0% minimum DBE goal assigned to this procurement.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

- 1.0 **PURPOSE/SCOPE:** This resolution will allow the Authority to enter into a contract for the furnishing of remanufactured Caterpillar C-9 fuel injectors, as specified, on a requirement basis for a period of three years.
- 2.0 **DESCRIPTION/JUSTIFICATION:** The Authority has an ongoing need to replace worn Caterpillar C-9 fuel injectors used on the 2600 and 2800 fleet of NABI buses. Periodic replacement of the injectors is required to ensure proper operation of the diesel engines.
- 3.0 **PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND:** The Invitation for Bid ("IFB") was posted on the GCRTA Procurement web site and advertised in the local newspapers. Fifteen interested parties downloaded the solicitation package. Two responsive bids were opened on May 29, 2019.

The Basis of Award is the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for the Total Estimated Contract Price.

The Procurement Department has determined the bid of Ohio Machinery Co., Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder. A price analysis has been performed and the Procurement Department has determined the price of Ohio Machinery Co., Inc. to be fair and reasonable to the Authority.

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- 4.0 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/DBE BACKGROUND: All Affirmative Action requirements have been met. A 0% DBE goal was established for this procurement due to the lack of certified DBE firms.
- 5.0 POLICY IMPACT: Does not apply.
- 6.0 ECONOMIC IMPACT: This procurement will be funded through the General Fund, Fleet Management Department budget, in an amount not to exceed \$314,372.90 for a period of three years. The bid price is approximately 1% above the budget estimate.
- 7.0 ALTERNATIVES: Reject this offer. Rejection of this offer could impact the timely repair of Caterpillar C-9 engines, which could impact service quality.
- 8.0 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the offer of Ohio Machinery Co., Inc. be accepted and the resolution passed authorizing the Interim CEO, General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer to enter into a contract.
