Overview

- CMSD wants to make public transportation available to its enrolled students in Grades 9-12.
- Agreement Term: 2024 2025 school year.
- The estimated value of this contract is \$2,500,000.



Overview

 GCRTA provides magnetic stripe farebox compatible picture ID cards.







Highlighted Terms

- 12,000 student ID cards/passes will be issued for student use on GCRTA vehicle as proof of payment.
- CMSD will make 10 monthly installment payments.
- GCRTA will provide CMSD a reconcilement of actual student rides and bill/credit CMSD on a quarterly basis at \$1.65 per ride.
- Any student tickets provided for services over and above this agreement will be at \$1.75/ride.



Recommendation

Staff requests that the Operational Planning & Infrastructure Committee recommend to the Board of Trustees the approval of the Intergovernmental Student Transportation Agreement with CMSD for the 2024-25 school year.
