At the November 5, 2024 Operational Planning and Infrastructure Committee meeting, staff will present a recommendation for consultant contract award to develop rehabilitation plans for the Guard Walls and Retaining Walls along the Blue Line near the Lee / Van Aken Train Station. The brick veneer on the Guard Walls and Retaining Walls has delaminated for most of the wall length which pose a potential safety hazard to pedestrians and are visually unappealing to the Shaker Heights community. The slope stability also needs to be reviewed, as well as cleanup and replanting of decorative trees.
